- Please pick up all students promptly.
- DANCERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WAIT OUTSIDE TO BE PICKED UP. THIS IS FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY AND PROTECTION.
- Upon entering the studio, a positive and professional attitude is expected of all students, siblings, and parents.
- Please have your dancers use the bathroom before class starts.
- Each dancer must mark their belongings clearly with their full name.
- No food is allowed in the studio dance rooms. Additionally, due to food allergies and length of classes, please do not bring in any celebration/birthday snacks. Seal-able water bottles may be brought into the studios.
- · For safety reasons, students may not chew gum or wear jewelry in class.
- Please refrain from talking or waving to your dancer though the viewing windows.
- Children may not be dropped off more than 10 minutes before scheduled class time. Siblings and friends will not be allowed in the lobby while class is in progress, nor are your dancers to be left unattended more than 10 minutes after class has finished.
- No one is allowed to run/play in the parking lot.
- If any dancer or her/his family is destructive to SDA property, the dancer's guardian is responsible for damages.
- SDA is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- NO STREET SHOES ARE ALLOWED IN THE DANCE STUDIOS.

Girls Beginning - Advanced

BOYS all levels:

- · White, black, or gray tshirt
- Black sweatpants or shorts
- Male ballet, jazz, and tap shoes are black

• Ballet: Pink, black, gray, or burgundy leotard; short skirts are allowed; pink leather or canvas

- ballet shoes; ballet pink matte tights
- Tap: Black lace-up tap shoes
- Jazz: Tan jazz shoes
- · Lyrical: Ballet shoes or barefoot
- Hip Hop: Clean tennis shoes
- You may wear a tank top/t-shirt & shorts, sweatpants, or leggings
- Hair securely off face. No large jewelry
- Dancers participating in a Jazz, Tap, or Hip Hop class only are not required to wear a leotard. Dancers in more than one class will not have time to change tights.
- Support undergarments must be worn if needed (preferably in studio dress code colors)

- All Boys: prices will be determined by the beginning of November. Costumes fees do not include shoes or tights.
- A specific newsletter regarding your costume fees and other information will be sent home in November before costumes are purchased. Showcase schedule will be tentatively set before payment date.
- SHOWCASE PERMISSION FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR EACH STUDENT.
- COSTUME PAYMENTS ARE DUE by December 5th, 2022. THEY MUST BE PAID IN FULL before costumes are ordered. There is NO REFUND for costumes once they have been ordered. This is the costume companu's policu.
- NO COSTUME WILL BE ORDERED UNLESS IT IS PAID IN FULL and all tuition payments are current. Families may NOT pay for a costume if their account is past due. Any money presented will be applied to past due tuition.
- SHOW TICKETS: Tickets to our Student Dance Showcase in June will need to be purchased. Dancers performing in the show *do not* need a ticket. More information on Show Tickets including when they will be available to purchase, will be included in the Student Dance Showcase packet released in November. The ticket pricing is \$14.00 per ticket.
